

#### **HOW YOUR DONATIONS ARE CHANGING LIVES**

#### Nusrat Mehboob (Housekeeping)

Nusrat Mehboob, a 39-year-old divorcee from Multan who had never worked before, after her divorce was put in a situation where she had to stand on her own feet to survive. She experienced many hardships in her life due to which she was unable to fulfill her family's financial needs. Her father passed away and no brothers to provide her a shelter, she had to take the responsibility of her ill mother along with a son to arrange for funds for his education. Major turning point in her life came when she enrolled herself in THF Housekeeping course at Multan campus. Nusrat credits the supportive instructors and the quality training at THF that helped her secure a job and become a bread earner for her family.



Soon after her graduation she was employed at a hospital where she is able to earn a respectable starting income of **Rs.15,000** which helped Nusrat to financially support her mother and son.

Being a hard working women she is motivated to build her career with a new skill learnt and a vision to increase her salary bracket. More importantly, for the first time in her life, Nusrat believes she has an identity and a sense of purpose in life. When you're brave, you empower others around you to be brave too. Since then she has encouraged other marginalized women like herself to also enroll into THF programs and gain financial independence and develop a career path.

Being the sole bread earner of a household having **05** individuals it was indeed very difficult for Muhammad Irshad to make both ends meet and take care of his family. Since his father disowned them after remarrying, so all the household responsibilities came on his shoulders; from paying healthcare bills of his mother to support his brother's education within his limited source of income.



But he never stopped dreaming to achieve his goals in life. THF became a blessing for him when he polished himself as a RAC Technician after completing his skills training program in Refrigeration & Air Conditioning trade. He expresses himself in a silvery voice: "The skills I learnt at THF will benefit me all my life and for this I am extremely grateful to my institute and instructors".

He is now employed at a renowned garment factory called, 'Cotton Web' in Lahore, earning a reputable monthly income of **Rs.24,000** which has helped him to lead a respectable life with dignity in society.


